

Emergency Rent and Utility Help

It's important to get a letter from your employer confirming that you have cut your hours or have been laid off.

 - <u>Security Deposits:</u> Your landlord must return your security deposit or provide a written accounting if it is not returned.
 - <u>Disability & Reasonable Accommodation</u>: If you or someone in your household has a disability, your landlord is required to make reasonable changes to rules and policies in order to give you an equal opportunity in your housing.
 - <u>Repairs:</u> Your landlord is required to make necessary repairs to keep your rental housing habitable.
 - Mold: Most varieties of mold and mildew do not pose a risk to your health. You and your landlord are both required to take certain action to prevent mold growth and remedy the causes of mold growth.



- <u>Infestation:</u> Visit the website for more information about your rights and responsibilities and steps you should take if your rental housing becomes infested with bedbugs, roaches, rats, or other pests.
- Lock-Outs & Unlawful Ouster: Your landlord is not allowed to lock you out of your rental housing without first giving you notice and getting an eviction judgment against you.
- <u>Termination Notices & Eviction:</u> The law requires that a landlord follow specific rules when giving a termination notice to a tenant. If the landlord does not follow those rules, the notice may not be enforceable and you may not have to move.
- <u>Small Claims Court:</u> If you have a dispute with your landlord and an attorney, housing advocate, or one of these guides suggests enforcing your rights in small claims court.
- <u>Manufactured Home Parks:</u> Residents of Manufactured Home Parks have different rights and responsibilities than other renters.
